About the WALFA Feedlot Ambassador Award

The WALFA Feedlot Ambassador Award is designed to encourage enthusiastic and dedicated participants of the WA feedlot industry to develop their skills and networks within the beef industry. Those that enter may be considering or participating in a leadership role within their current organization. Young people with a passion for the lot feeding industry within WA are encouraged to apply for this award.

Criteria to Apply

To be eligible to be awarded the WALFA Feedlot Ambassador Award, you must be:

- 30 years or younger as of 31st December 2022.
- Employed at a feedlot that is a current financial Member of WALFA.

The Application Process

To apply for the WA Feedlot Ambassador Award, you need to:

- 1. Complete the below Application Form and return to <u>eo@walotfeeders.com.au</u> by the <u>23 December 2022</u>. This is to include a letter of endorsement (from an employer, colleague, business partner, client etc).
- 2. Attend an interview with the WALFA Award's selection panel (date TBC, likely early February 2023).
- 3. Present to the WALFA Board (date TBC, likely in March 2023).
- 4. The winner will be announced at the Beef Connections Dinner, during BetterBeef23 (30 March 2023).

Prize

The WALFA Feedlot Ambassador Awardee will receive an **all-expenses-paid trip to ALFA's SmartBeef in 2023** (valued at \$6000). This is to include:

- 1. Return flights to SmartBeef.
- 2. Up to 4 nights' accommodation, to attend SmartBeef.
- 3. Registration to SmartBeef.
- 4. Potential for an organised visit to an eastern state's feedlot while at SmartBeef.
